
CORONA (COVID-19):


KATUPOTHA:

During this corona period, where the children cannot go to school, this is especially important.

In the past few months, the children have celebrated several occasions. They celebrated Buddha's birthday. Unfortunately, due to Covid, they were not allowed to go to the temple. They made beautiful decorations and celebrated the feast together.









The month of May is always dedicated to Mary, the mother of Jesus. This month normally ends with a procession. Of course, that wasn't possible, because of Corona. They now held their own procession, in the garden of the home. The children celebrate all these feasts together. That way they learn from each other. Also, to respect each other's beliefs. Which is quite wonderful!
